

Primary Physical Education and Sport Premium Funding 2017/18

Sacred Heart RC Primary School

The Government is providing additional funding for academic year 2017 to 2018 to improve provision of physical education and sport in primary schools. The funding is ring fenced to be used for sport specific areas to make an impact in physical education and sport in schools. Sacred Heart has received –this financial year Schools are free to determine how best to use this funding to improve the quality and breadth of physical education and sport provision, including increasing participation in physical education and sport so that all pupils develop healthy lifestyles and reach the performance levels they are capable of.

Sport Premium Funding Allocation for 2017 – 2018 is £18100

The Primary PE and Sport Premium Vision

All pupils leaving primary school physically literate and with the knowledge, skills and motivation necessary to equip them for a healthy lifestyle and lifelong participation in physical activity and sport.

We would expect indicators of such improvement to include:

- the engagement of all pupils in regular daily physical activity – kick-starting healthy active lifestyles
- self-sustaining improvement in the quality of physical education and sport
- increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport
- increased pupil participation in competitive sport
- broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils
