Dear Parents/Carers

As part of our DT/Geography topics, a school trip to Delamere Forest has been arranged for Year 5 pupils on Thursday 8th February 2018. The children will learn about the parts of plants and trees, what they need to grow and about the trees and their importance in the local environment through fun games and activities. “Amazing Forests” includes a sensory activity walk to discover the trees of the forest in a unique way.

Pupils who normally have a school dinner will be provided with a school packed lunch. Pupils who normally bring a packed lunch should bring their lunch as normal. All packed lunches should be in disposable packaging which can all be thrown away after lunch.

The children will travel to Delamere by minibus and will be leaving school at **8:30am** and will arrive back **approximately 3:30pm**. Please could you ensure your child **arrives to school at 8:15am** on this day. The minibus needs to depart at **8:30am promptly** so please ensure your child is not late for school.

Children will need to be dressed in their school jumper or cardigan, appropriate bottoms to suit the weather, sensible footwear (such as wellies), hat, gloves and a waterproof coat.

So that the trip can go ahead we are asking for a voluntary contribution from parents of £10.00 per child. If paying by cash, your contribution should be posted in the red post box at the school office. Please ensure your child's name is clearly marked on the front of the envelope.
