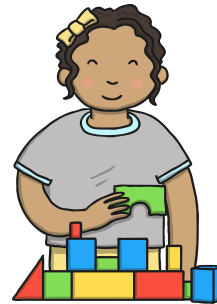

Next Week in Reception

Literacy - We are reading the book Bear's Winter House. Please talk to your child about what they see, hear, smell in winter and also during the different seasons throughout the year.

Phonics - We will be learning new sounds, high frequency words and tricky words daily. How many of these tricky words can your child read and write? *He, she, we, be, you, me, was, all they, my.*

Just a Reminder
