World Food Wednesday –Pasta and sauce, Tortilla boats. Hot sandwich specials. Fresh fruit & yogurt.

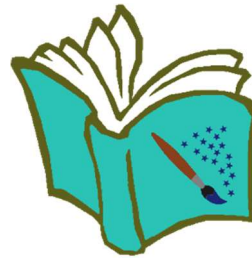
Thursday Favourites – Picnic Day
