





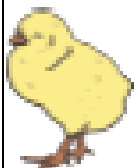
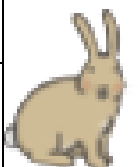
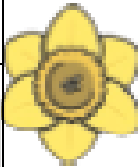
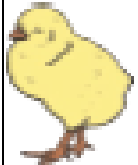


Idea	Example
<p>Baking for all of the family. Could you bake an Easter treat? This could be some rice crispy baskets, a cake or something savoury!</p>	
<p>Write a poem. Can you write a poem about Easter? This could be an acrostic poem; it may be a rhyming poem, or even a shape poem!</p>	
<p>Can you use things you have in your house to make an Easter puppet?</p>	
<p>Easter egg hunt! This could work two ways. The adults could prepare a hunt for the children, or, the children could write clues and make a hunt for the adults!</p>	
<p>Pin the tail on the bunny. An old party game, brought to life for Easter</p>	
<p>Paint a pebble. This could have an Easter theme, or it could be one to cheer up someone you don't know. Why don't you leave it out for people to see while they are out walking?</p>	





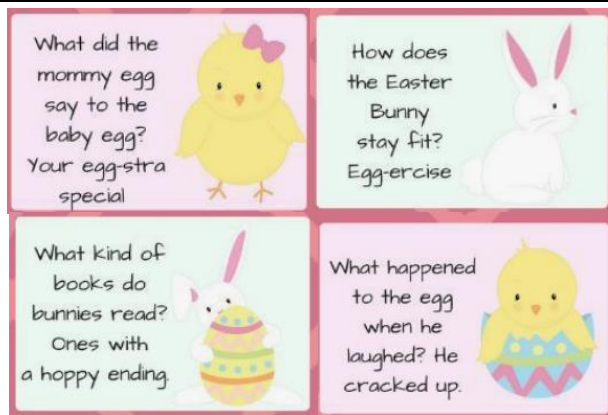
Make an Easter card.

This could be for someone in your house; you could post it to a family member, or send it to a care home!



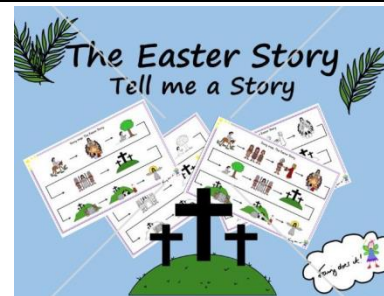
Make someone laugh.
