As we are operating with a very limited number of staff and we are all trying to support the worldwide intervention to reduce the spread of Covid-19 disease, I am appealing to key worker parents to only request a school place if you are currently working in a role that is absolutely critical to the Covid-19 response and you have no other child care.

The government has specifically stated that:

‘if it is possible for children to be at home, then they should be.’

If you have other suitable childcare within your household or a household that your child is still visiting (for example, if you are separated - the other carer’s home), then children should stay at home or in the other household.

If you or your partner are working from home then your child should stay at home.
