Dear Parents/Carers,

A school trip to Sugar Brook Farm in Altrincham has been arranged for Class 5 pupils on Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> October 2021. As part of our Food and Farming Project the children will have lots of opportunities to meet and handle various farm animals including hens, sheep, cattle and horses. A tour of the farm will allow the children to learn about what the animals eat, how they're looked. After lunch we will go on a nature walk through the fields to study different habitats on the farmland including the pond, meadow and woodland.

Pupils who normally have a school dinner will be provided with a school packed lunch. Pupils who normally bring a packed lunch should bring their lunch as normal. All packed lunches should be in disposable packaging which can all be thrown away after lunch.

The children will travel to Sugar Brook by coach and will be leaving school at **9:00am** and will arrive back **approximately 3:15pm**. Please could you ensure your child **arrives to school at 8:50am** on this day.

Children will need to be dressed in their school jumper or cardigan, appropriate bottoms to suit the weather, sensible footwear (such as wellies), hat, gloves and a waterproof coat.

So that the trip can go ahead we are asking for a voluntary contribution from parents of £8 per child.

**If sufficient contributions are not received by Monday 11<sup>th</sup> October, the trip will have to be cancelled.**
