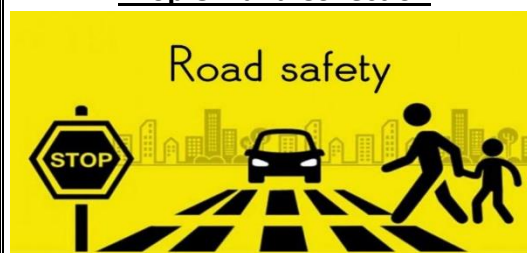


Class Attendance Winners 26.11.21
