


# Sacred Heart RC Primary School 'Where Every Heart is Sacred'

<u>Class 5</u> Harley – Fantastic contributions to lesson and always being kind to others. **Anu** - Excellent literacy work and presentation.


<u>Class 6</u> Kenrick and Noah – Amazing scores during assessment week proving excellent progress.
