Class 1 Computing

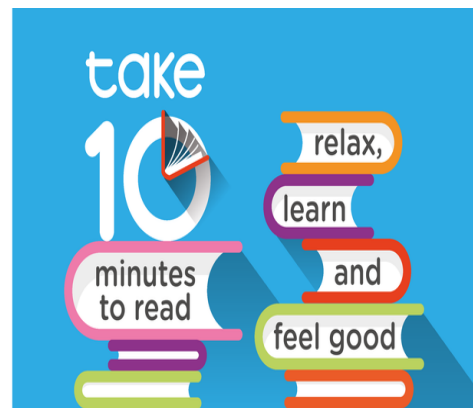
Class 1 have been learning about representing data in their computing lessons by representing zoo animals with different coloured cubes. They will be working towards representing data on a computer.
