Swimming

As part of the National Curriculum, KS2 children are expected to meet age-related expectations in swimming. They should be able to:

- swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres
- use a range of strokes effectively [for example, front crawl, backstroke and breaststroke]
- perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations

Children in Year 5 and 6 who have not met these targets will have the opportunity during the summer term to attend some additional sessions on Wednesday mornings. However, they would benefit significantly if they were to take swimming lessons during weekends or school holidays or simply visit the swimming baths more regularly. Manchester City Council offer free swimming sessions to primary aged children and you can find more information by visiting www.better.org.uk/manchester/free-swimming.
