Class 9 Evan – Wonderful perseverance and resilience and not giving up when he found his work tricky. **Noyo** A shining example and role-model every single day.

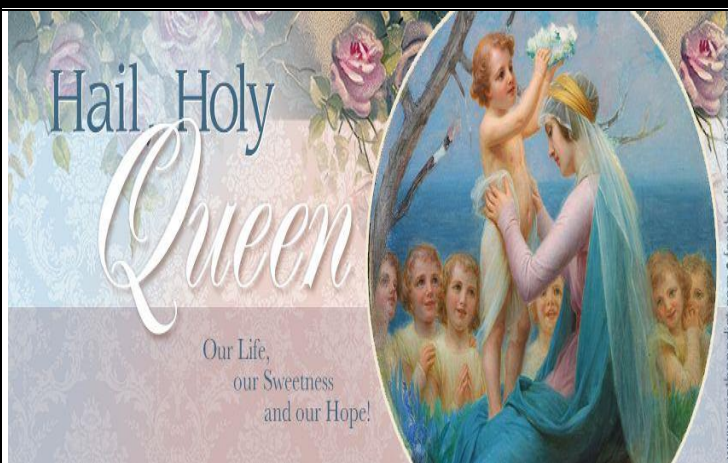
Class 9 and The Road to Emmaus
