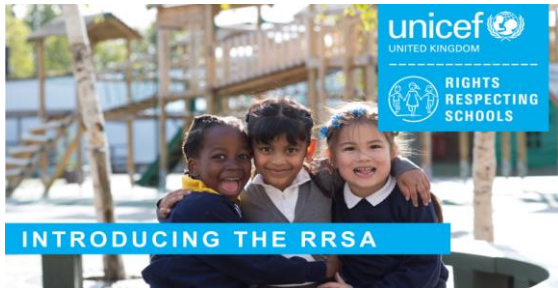




### Rights Respecting School

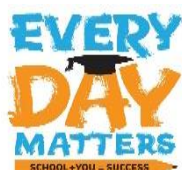
