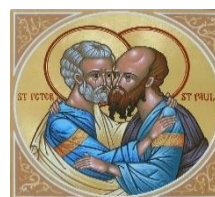
### First Holy Communions

**BOYS**

- White or Pale Blue Polo Shirt
- Blue Sweatshirt (with school logo)
- Navy Blue, Black or Grey Trousers or Shorts
