Don't forget, school reopens on Monday 30th October.

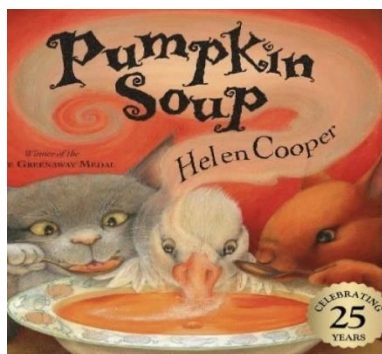
