Dear Parents/Carers,

A school trip to Northwood Farm in Burnley has been arranged for Class 6 pupils on Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> June 2024. As part of our Food and Farming Project, the children will have lots of opportunities to meet and handle various farm animals including hens, sheep and cattle. A tour of the farm will allow the children to learn about the food animals eat and how they're cared for. There will also be a nature walk when the children will study different habitats on the farmland.

Pupils who normally have a school dinner will be provided with a school packed lunch. Pupils who normally bring a packed lunch should bring their lunch as normal. All packed lunches should be in disposable packaging which can all be thrown away after lunch.

The children will travel to Northwood Farm by coach and will be leaving school at **9:00am** and will arrive back **approximately 3:15pm**. Please could you ensure your child **arrives to school at 8:45am** on this day.

Children will need to be dressed in their school jumper or cardigan, appropriate bottoms to suit the weather, sensible footwear (such as wellies), hat, gloves and a waterproof coat.

So that the trip can go ahead, we are asking for a voluntary contribution from parents of  $\pounds 10$  per child.
