Year 6 SATs 13th to 16th May

Don't forget that our Year 6 children will take their SATs tests from 13th May to 16th May. Children must be present on these dates. The SATs tests are of great importance and will be a celebration of the progress each child has made throughout their primary education. Year 6 have been invited to attend breakfast club between 13th and 16th May from 8am in order to support their preparation for the day ahead.

Year 1 Phonics Screening Check 10th to 14th June

The phonics screening check is taken individually by all children in Year 1 in England and will be take place **week beginning 10th June**. It is designed to give parents and teachers information on how your child is progressing in phonics. It will help to identify whether your child needs additional support so that they do not fall behind in this vital early reading skill.

There are two sections in the 40-word check and it assesses phonics skills and knowledge learned through Reception and Year 1. Your child will read up to four words per page for their teacher and they will do the check in one sitting of about 5–10 minutes. There is also further information on the school website about the teaching of phonics and the correct sounds to use to support your child at home.

Year 4 Multiplications Check 10th to 14th June

After the half term break, Year 4 children will take the Multiplications Check. The purpose of the check is to determine whether your child can fluently recall their times tables up to 12, which is essential for future success in mathematics. It will also help us identify if your child may need additional support. It is an on-screen check consisting of 25 times table questions. Your child will be able to answer 3 practice questions before taking the actual check. They will then have 6 seconds to answer each question. On average, the check should take no longer than 5 minutes to complete.
