

## TT Rockstars Relaunch!

#### THURSDAY 19TH SEPTEMBER

TT Rockstars is an excellent platform for helping children to learn vital multiplication and division facts. It is used by every child from Y2-Y6 and we encourage children to spend 5 minutes Rockstars minutes each day because quick and accurate recall of timetables facts not only helps children to pass their Multiplication Check at the end of Year 4, but also helps them to complete many more increasingly complex mathematical operations such as the multiplication and division of fractions and increasing/decreasing numbers by two-digit percentages.

To relaunch Rockstars for the new academic year, we are inviting children to come to school dressed as rockstars for the day on **Thursday 19th September** (no monetary contribution is required). If you would like some costume inspiration, please search <u>TTRockstars Dress Up</u>. There will be a prize for the best dressed in each key stage (and the best dressed member of staff as well!).

Children can log into their Rockstars accounts through Wonde or directly with their TT Rockstars passwords. Please ask your child's class teacher or teaching assistant if you need any support to access Rockstars or have any questions or queries.

## Attendance

### 'In school on time every day.'

The children at Sacred Heart School have consistently had an outstanding record of attendance and we have consistently been amongst the schools with the highest attendance record overall in Manchester and England for many years. Every school day is an essential learning day and crucial to the development of children. Apart from rare, exceptional circumstances such as entrance exams, elite sporting competitions or secondary school interviews, no absences will be authorised unless due to illness or medical appointments that absolutely cannot be taken outside of the school day (e.g. hospital appointments/emergency dentists). In England, holidays during term time will no longer be authorised under any circumstances. Please ensure children arrive at 8.45am each day as just 1 minute missed of the first lesson of the day can have a negative impact on their learning. Our new attendance policy will be ratified by governors at our next full governors' meeting and I will share it with you in the following newsletter.
