# Gaudete Sunday

Let the joy commence!



This Sunday we celebrate Gaudete Sunday: we observe the Church light a rose-colored candle in the Advent wreath and, as well, the priest dons rose-colored vestments. Gaudete means "rejoice" in Latin. This particular Sunday in the season is associated with the rose color that symbolises joy in the celebration of being with Jesus again in His coming. While the rest of the season is symbolised by purple's penitential color, this bright hued color symbolises joy in the midst of waiting in Advent's season of penance.

Saint Paul said to the Philippians in his epistle, "Rejoice in the Lord always; again, I will say, Rejoice. The Lord is near." (Philippians 4:4–5) As we celebrate Gaudete Sunday, let us be reminded of the reason for our celebration. May we be joyfully assured of the coming of Jesus as we faithfully wait for Him in this season of Advent.






## Carol Singing in the Community


